**Guideline for selection of candidates and contractual engagement of
569 Medical Technologists (Laboratory, X-ray/RD & ECG)
in different Government Hospitals out of existing vacant post
as per G.O. no. HF/O/MA/1991/4C-16/2016, dated 28.10.2016**

A. Method of Selection of Candidates:

1. **Criteria for selection:** Criteria for selection of candidates will be as prescribed in existing Rules regulating the Recruitment to the different posts under Medical Technologist Cadre of the West Bengal Subordinate Health Services, vide Notification no HF/O/MA/2444/TDE /3D-51/2004, dated 06.08.2009.

a. Qualification :

I. For Medical Technologist (Laboratory):

- (i) **Essential:** Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or it's equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology and a two year diploma in Laboratory Technologist recognized in the Government of West Bengal;

OR

One year diploma course in Laboratory Technology from any University/ Institution recognized by the Government of West Bengal; where basic qualification for undergoing the said course is B. Sc,

- (ii) **Desirable:** One year training after acquiring diploma in Laboratory Technology recognized by the Government of West Bengal in any Government Hospital or in a Clinical Establishment licensed under West Bengal Clinical Establishment Rules 2003.

II. For Medical Technologist (Radio Diagnostics):

- (i) **Essential:** Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or it's equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology and a two year diploma in Radiography (Diagnostics) DRD (Tech.) recognized in the Government of West Bengal;

- (ii) **Desirable:** One year training after acquiring diploma in Radiography (Diagnostics) DRD (Tech.) recognized by the Government of West Bengal in any Government Hospital or in a Clinical Establishment licensed under West Bengal Clinical Establishment Rules 2003;

OR

A postgraduate diploma in Radiography (Diagnostics) DRD (Tech.) from any recognized university.

III. For Medical Technologist (ECG):

- (i) **Essential:** Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or it's equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology and a two year diploma in ECG Technology recognized in the Government of West Bengal;

- (ii) **Desirable:** One year training after acquiring diploma in ECG Technology recognized by the Government of West Bengal in any Government Hospital or in a Clinical Establishment licensed under West Bengal Clinical Establishment Rules 2003.

OR

A postgraduate diploma in ECG technology from any recognized university.

- b. **Age limit:** Not less than 18 years and more than 37 years on the 1st January of the year of advertisement. Provided that the provisions of West Bengal Services (Raising Age Limit) Rules, 1981 shall apply as long as the same remain in force. *Provided also that age may be relaxed for the candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes as per Government rules or orders from time to time.*

2. **Method of selection for engagement:** Selection of candidates for contractual engagement of mentioned three categories of Medical Technologists for District Hospitals and Multi/ Super Speciality Hospitals in districts will be done by the existing District Level Selection Committee for contractual engagement of staff of the concerned district and for Medical College Hospitals and Teaching Hospitals will be done by the Committee as stated in the above mentioned G.O.

The CMOH of the district and the MSVP of Medical College Hospitals and Teaching Hospitals will arrange to issue notice inviting application from the eligible candidates for selection of candidates for the respective facility mentioning category and number allotted for engagement and criteria for selection through wide circulation of the notice in prominent daily newspapers and after receiving the applications, the mentioned selection committee will select the suitable candidates for the category and number wise Medical Technologist allotted for the facility.

Scoring as per Essential and Desirable qualification & Interview will be as follows:

Then the CMOH of the district and the MSVP of Medical College Hospitals and Teaching Hospitals will send the list of such selected candidates mentioning their name, category, father's name, address, date of birth, qualification (essential & desirable if any) and score obtained as per attached format to the Director of Health Services, West Bengal for final approval.

- B. **Method of Engagement of the candidates on contractual basis:** After obtaining final approval from the of the end of the Director Health Services, West Bengal, the CMOH of the district and the MSVP of Medical College Hospitals and Teaching Hospitals will engage the selected concerned Medical Technologist on contractual basis on execution of individual contract.
